- *Road construction began in 1892 – during the reign of Queen Liliuokalani*
- *10 mile loop / About 200 homes*
- *Peak elevation – 1,800 feet*
- *Access to an extended network of 15 scenic trails*

- *Supplements regular volunteer opportunity with Work Day (quarterly)*
- *Complements City & County roadside maintenance*

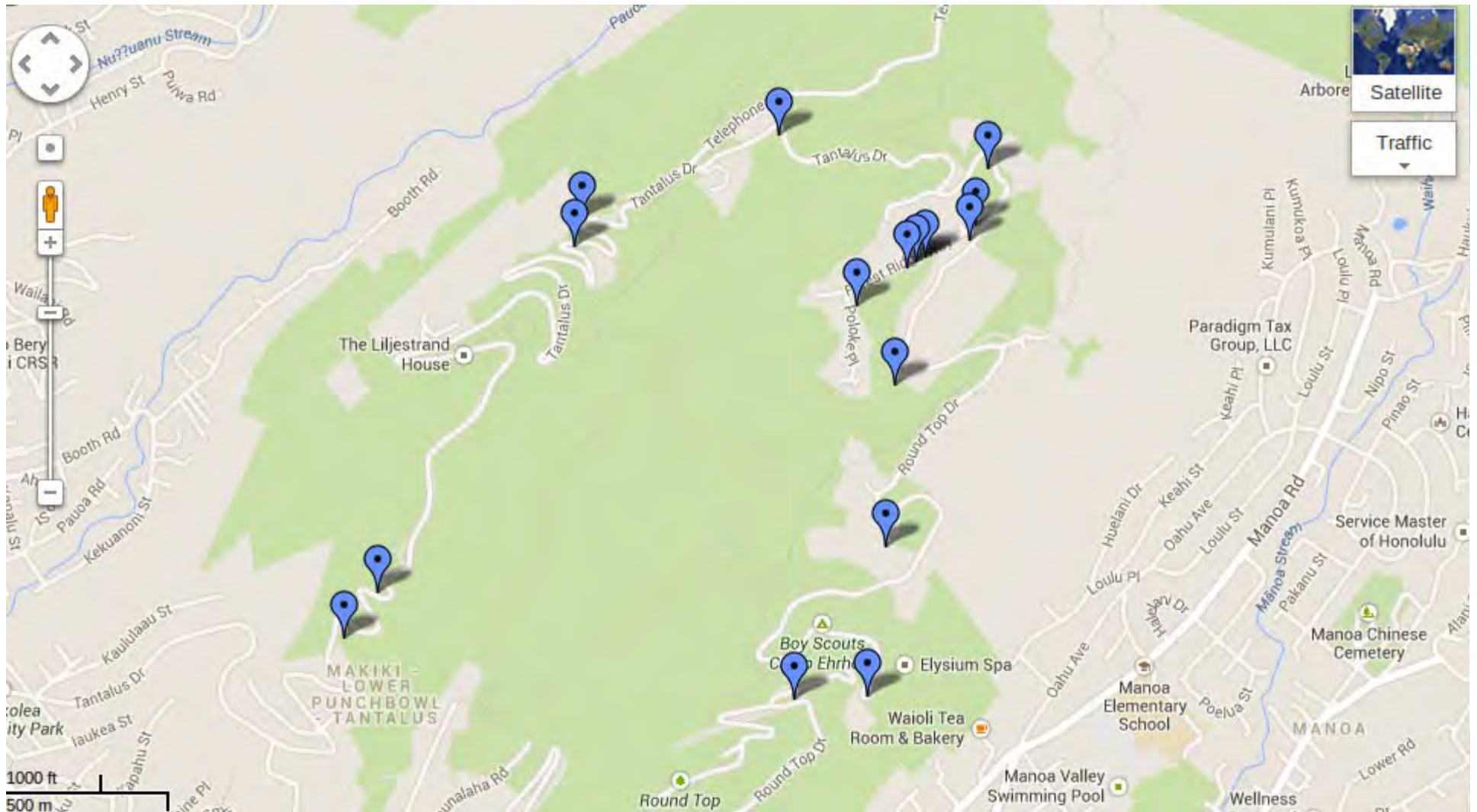
